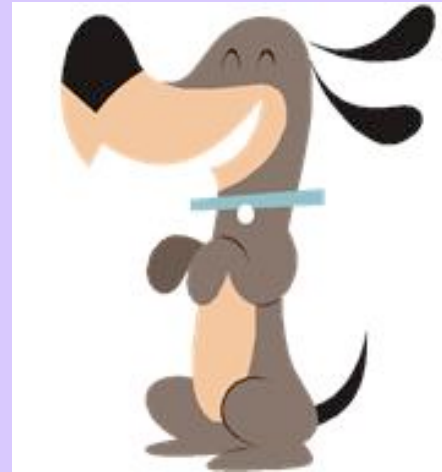

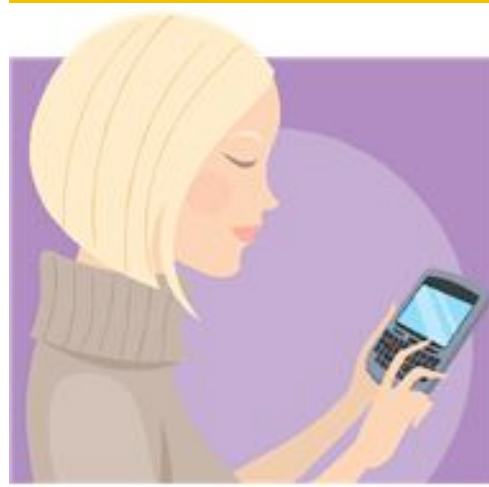

Please Tell Us You're Home

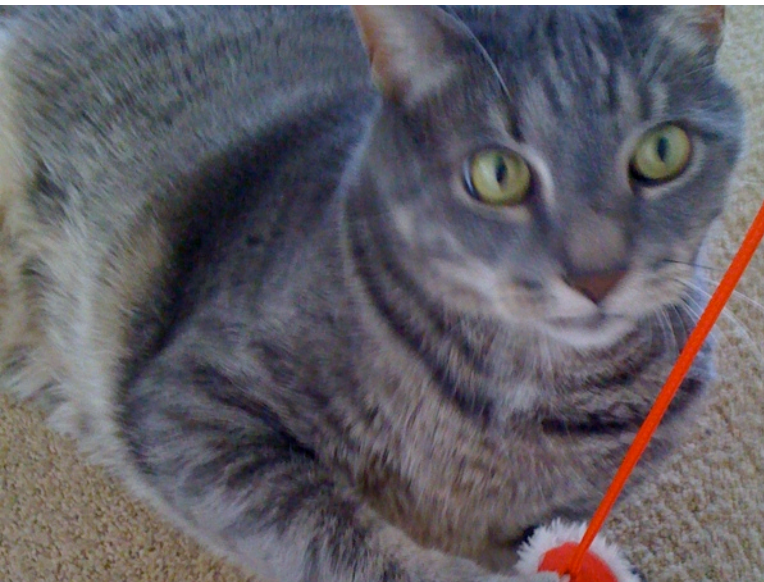
